What is PLAN? PEER-LED ACTIVITIES IN NUTRITION

• Directed education combined with PSE (policy, system, environment) interventions through student-led, project based learning.

 Development of student-based individual wellness goals, AND class/group-based wellness goals.

 Teaches students how their choices impact their health, community, and environment.

Single Lessons

(Direct Education Only)

Lesson Series

(Direct Education Only)

Deliver two or more lessons in order from research based curricula.



Full PSE Intervention

Combine lessons with project sessions for full series.
